# **Software Application Support**

This is a project-based hands-on experience in software development, unit/regression testing, agile/scrum methodologies, programming in <u>ASP.NET</u> MVC, database programming in T-SQL and code management through Team Foundation Server. Volunteers will put their basic software programming skills to practice by creating new features to existing applications. Individuals with verbal and customer service skills will also have the opportunity to provide technical assistance to users, enhance existing software to suit user's needs and create technical documentations.

# User Experience, Website development, Business Analysis and Quality Assurance

Volunteers will be participating in the initial and the final phase of the software development cycle. Individuals with interests in business analysis and user experience will have the opportunity to use their great communication, writing and presentation skills by performing requirement gathering, wireframe design, writing user guides, quality assurance testing and conducting user training sessions. Volunteers with interests in user experience and website development will have the opportunity to design and develop websites using web development tool like WordPress.
